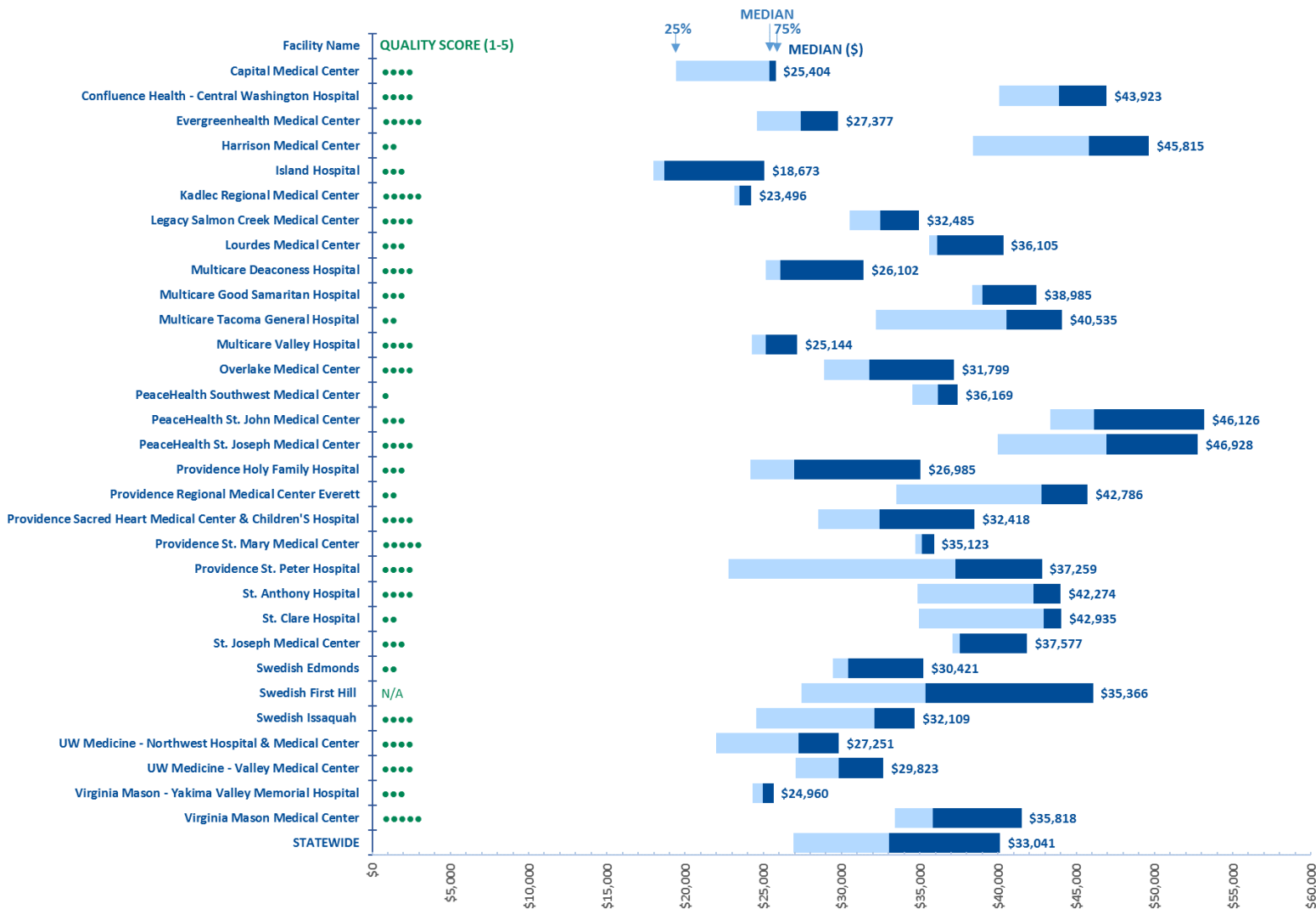


Do You Need Hip Replacement Surgery?

 The Washington All-Payer Health Care Claims Database (WA-APCD) is the state's most complete source of health and dental claims data. It contains claims from more than 30 commercial health care payers; the Medicaid program, including its five managed care plans; Medicare; and the workers' compensation program. The WA-APCD has historical claims data beginning with 2013, and the database is systematically updated each calendar quarter with the most current claims data.



Quality Scores

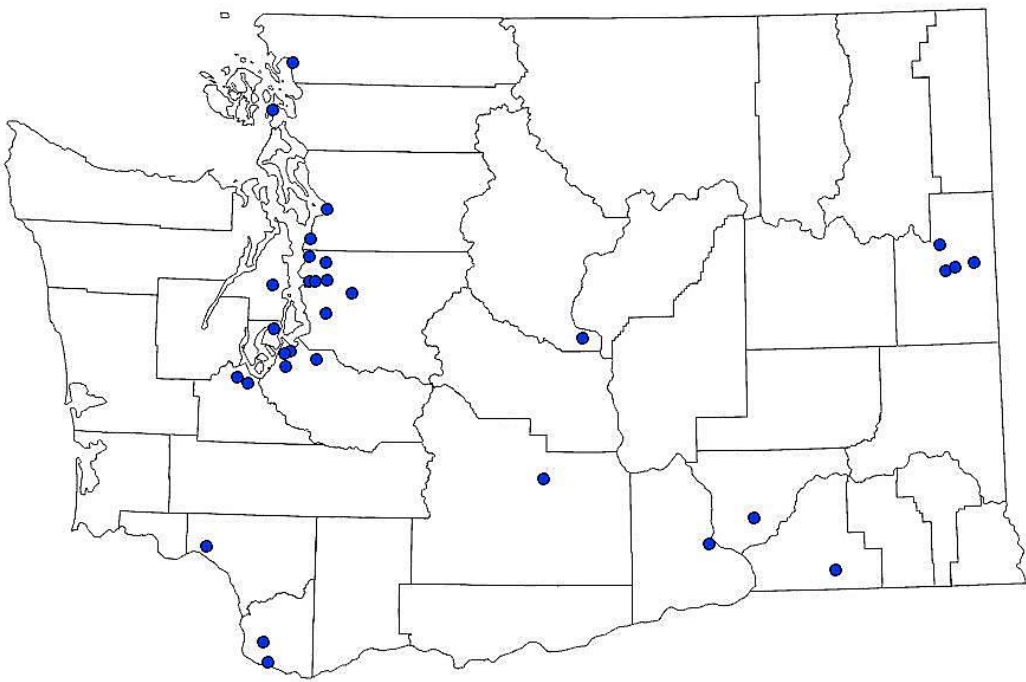
The Overall Quality Score is produced by the U.S. Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) by summarizing a large number of quality measures into a single star-based rating. CMS grades each hospital's performance using a scale of one to five stars and shows how a hospital's quality compares to all hospitals nationwide. Prices

Price is the total amount paid to the hospital for the Hip Replacement Surgery — a combination of payments by the insurer and the patient, including fees paid to the hospital, the doctor, and any other health professionals. The prices are computed using claims records from the WA-APCD for people with commercial health insurance in 2017. Median, 25th percentile, and 75th percentile prices are shown.
